Environmentfriendly Funerals and Carbon Offsetting

We are all now more conscious of the impact we are having on the environment and at Mears Family Funerals we are committed to reducing our carbon emissions and to become net zero by 2050.

The carbon emissions generated by the operation of our I2 branches are offset through Tree Nation's CO2 Neutral Team scheme. 26 trees are planted each month to offset activities such as electricity usage, office materials and the commute of the staff and nearly 4 tonnes of carbon emissions are offset each month.

In our endeavour to provide meaningful and sustainable farewell ceremonies, we have partnered with Tree Nation, a leading reforestation initiative, to offer our clients the opportunity to offset the carbon emissions generated by a funeral by planting trees in the UK.



For just £95, we will plant trees in the UK to offset 340kg of carbon emissions produced by the average hearse only funeral. We have calculated the carbon emissions generated by



our private ambulance travelling up to 40 miles (I4kg), our hybrid-powered hearse travelling up to 40 miles (9kg), and the emissions generated by the average UK cremation (I80kg). The balance is used to offset the emissions generated by activities such as coffin manufactureand delivery, our Care Centre operations, funeral staff travel etc.

Additional trees can be purchased to offset the emissions of limousines if requested. The carbon emissions generated by family and friends attending the funeral can be offset with additional trees clients can choose to gift them in memory of a loved one or invite family and friends to plant a tree in the Mears Family Funerals forest.

We can calculate the carbon emissions for your bespoke funeral arrangement on request.
